**Section 2:** If any provision of this ordinance is determined to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remaining provisions shall remain in force and affect.

Whereas, for accurate accounting the Town desires to establish a separate fund number for the receipt and expenditures of the Public Works Trust Fund Loan, and


Whereas, the available fund number is 410.

Now, therefore, the Town Council of the Town of South Prairie, Pierce County, Washington do ordain as follows:





**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SOUTH PRAIRIE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2007.**

**Whereas**, the Mayor of the Town of South Prairie has completed and placed on file with the Town Clerk a proposed budget and estimated amounts of money required to meet public expenses, bond retirement expenses, reserve expenses, expenses of government of the Town for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2007 and a public hearing was held permitting the taxpayers an opportunity to be heard on the said budget,

**Whereas**, the proposed budget does not exceed the lawful limit of taxation allowed by law to be levied upon property within the Town for the purposes set forth in the said budget and for the estimated expenditures set forth in said budget being all necessary to carry on the government of the Town for the year 2007 and being sufficient to meet the various needs of the Town during the year 2007.

**Now, therefore, the Town Council of the Town of South Prairie, Pierce County, Washington do ordain as follows:**



**Section 4:** If any provision of this ordinance is determined to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, or any provisions on the attachment(s) are determined to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remaining provisions of this ordinance, and the remaining provisions of the attachment(s) shall remain in force and affect.

**Section 5:** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.






